Totem is currently on its 19th volume; the first volume was published in 1994. 2010-2011 will also be the first year Totem publishes online through Weldon Library Services and the Scholarship@Western program.

Totem's mandate is to publish exceptional works of creative and original research by undergraduate and graduate students in any of the four sub-fields of anthropology including socio-cultural anthropology, archaeology, biological/physical anthropology, and linguistics.
